Yippee!

Set your FRS walkie-talkie radios to channel 7. Gas tanks should be full.

Depart from the Anderson Regional Transportation Center at 09:00 AM

Drive Time: ~2 hours Distance: ~125 miles each way.

Directions –

- 1. Take the ramp onto I-95 South for 16 miles**
- 2. Take exit 25 for I-90 W/Mass. Pike and continue for 32 miles**
- 3. From the Mass Pike, take exit 10 for I-290 E/I-395 S toward Worcester**
- 4. When going South on I-395 – we will try to keep to about 65 to 70 mph to keep everyone together**
- 5. I-395 is a 2 lane interstate with medium to possibly heavy truck traffic**



Welcome to Connecticut

NOTE: There will be several rest stop opportunities along this route.

- 6. Merge with I-95 south at exit 76 – Note: this is a left exit**
- 7. Exit 71 – This is where we get off of I-95 – go left at end of exit ramp onto Four Mile**
- 8. River Road – Go over bridge and take an immediate right onto Hatchedts Hill Road just over bridge – Go about .6 mile – Go right onto High St.**

Our destination – Callaway Cars Inc., 3 High Street, Old Lyme CT 0637 – 860-434-9002

Parking is limited but our host will reserve their front lot for our tour. Callaway Tours are personalized, nominally 20 per group, and we have allowed for about 2 hours. What you will see is whatever is in the shop on that day. Our Callaway point of contact is Mike Vendetto (860) 434-9002

Depart Callaway for lunch stop at about 1:00 PM

- Go left from High St. onto Hatchedts Hill Road – Go about .6 Miles – Go Right onto Four
- Mile River Road for about .5 mile – Stop sign – Take an acute left onto route 156
- Take CT Coastal route #156 (eastbound) into Niantic [caution beach traffic]
- In Niantic take a left onto route 161 (northbound)
- Continue north and Go under I-95 – our lunch destination is on the left just after the interchange.
