In Burlington, MA, take exit 32A to Route 3 North. Take exit 26 (Route 62 Burlington/Bedford) and go straight through set of lights at end of ramp onto Crosby Drive. At the end of Crosby, take a right on the Middlesex Turnpike and an immediate left onto Plank Street. At the end of Plank, take a right on Dunham Road. Dunham curves to the left. We are at 50 Dunham Road on the left. Look for the yellow and black sign for American Automotive Aftermarket (AAA Work Trucks).

Directions From 495

In Lowell, MA, take exit 35B to Route 3 South towards Burlington. Take Exit 26 (Route 62 Bedford/Burlington). At the end of the ramp, take a left onto Route 62 East. At the next intersection of lights, take a left on to Crosby Drive. At the end of Crosby, take a right on the Middlesex Turnpike and an immediate left onto Plank Street. At the end of Plank, take a right on Dunham Road. Dunham curves to the left. We are at 50 Dunham Road on the left. Look for the yellow and black sign for American Automotive Aftermarket (AAA Work Trucks).
