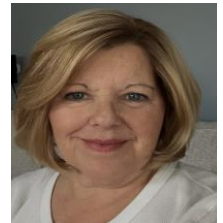

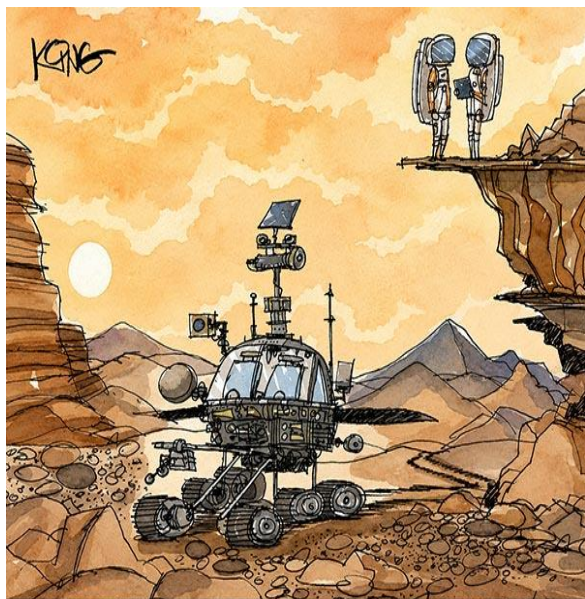

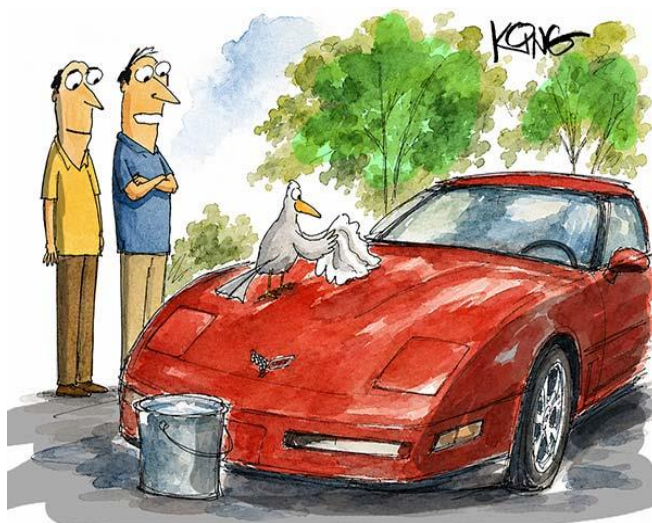

A Piece of History



This Month In Corvette History: **Where the Modern Era Begins**

In 1981, Corvette production was moved to a state-of-the-art facility in Bowling Green, Kentucky, where it remains today. This marked a new chapter in the Corvette's history when the first Corvette rolled off the line on June 1, 1981.



The Bowling Green Assembly Plant has been solely responsible for producing Corvette models from the end of the third generation to the current eighth generation. Bowling Green Assembly also builds high-performance Corvettes like the Z06, ZR1, ZR1X, and E-Ray. Production of 2027 Corvettes at Bowling Green Assembly, including the newly unveiled Grand Sport, begins this month.

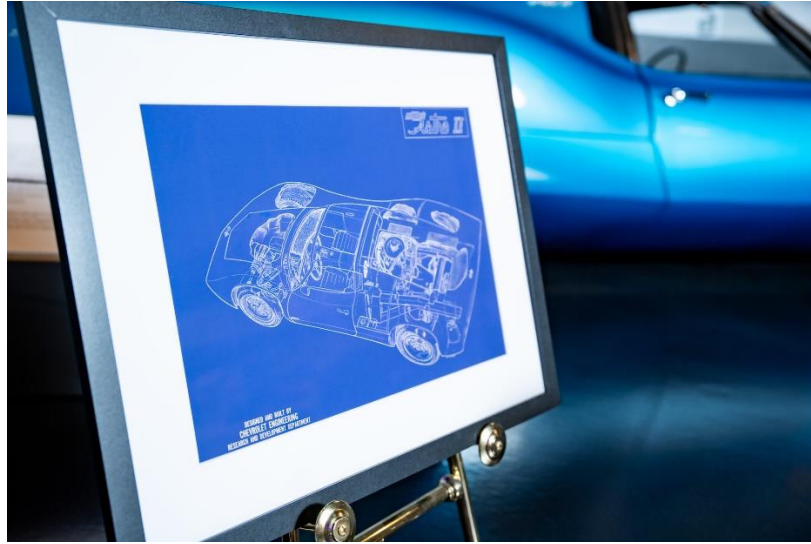

Tech Tip of the Month

This month's top Corvette tech tip focuses on **battery preservation and health** for both C7 and C8 models. Because Corvettes are packed with complex electronics that draw power—even when parked—preventing parasitic drain is essential to avoid electrical glitches or a dead battery. Tech Tip: Use a Trickle Charger for Parked Corvettes

If you are storing your Corvette or not driving it for a week or more, connect a high-quality, smart trickle charger.

- **C8/C7 Tip:** Utilize the designated trickle charger or battery maintainer that connects directly through the charging port in the trunk. This ensures a healthy state of charge and saves the onboard modules from throwing diagnostic error codes caused by low voltage.

General Service Reminders by Generation

- **C8 (2020+):** Always observe the **1,500-mile break-in period** before tracking the car. Do not track it aggressively on the factory fill of transmission fluid; ensure the fluid level has been properly inspected and topped off according to factory specs. [\[1\]](#)
- **C7 (2014-2019):** Periodically check and clean out the "**udders**" (the cowl drains near the windshield wipers) and check your cabin air filter, as leaves and debris frequently collect here, leading to water backup or musty odors.
- **C5/C6 (1997-2013):** If your headlight motors begin grinding, a simple \$10 gear replacement kit (often swapping the brittle factory plastic gear for a brass one) is typically all you need rather than replacing the entire assembly.

No Side Intake Screen Protection Available for 2027 Corvette ZR1/ZR1X Orders

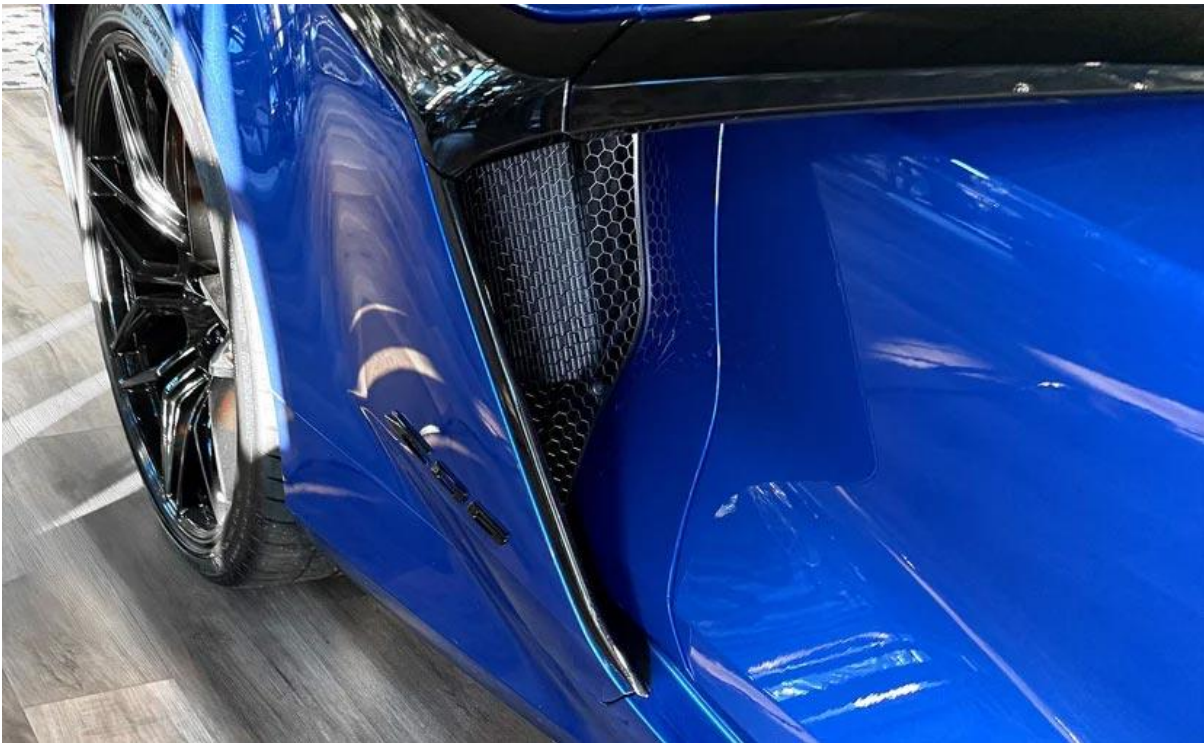

At the beginning of 2026, Chevrolet introduced a new LPO (dealer-installed) option for grille screens called the [Grille Screen Protection Package \(PCQ\)](#). The package bundled the grille screen protection for the front radiators (VWE) and the side intakes (VWT) for a combined cost of \$1,675. The package saves \$70 off the cost of the individual options, and as these are dealer installed, you get them done before you take delivery of your Corvette.

While the package is available for the 2027 Grand Sport and Z06, unfortunately, the grille screen protection package isn't yet available for the [Corvette ZR1](#) or ZR1X. This week, Chevrolet sent out a distribution update for the 2027 Corvette Order Guide to alert buyers and sales reps. By updating the Order Guide with a footnote, it removes the item from the constraints list.

The problem apparently has to do with supplies as its the ZR1/ZR1X-specific side intake grille screens (VWT) that are not available. Both the PCQ package and the VWT Side Intake screens were marked as "Not available at this time":

- **ZR1 and ZR1X Exterior section**-(PCQ) LPO, Grille Screen Protection Package, added a footnote 1 to all equipment groups that reads "Not available at this time."
- **ZR1 and ZR1X Exterior section**-(VWT) LPO, Insect protection grille screen, updated footnote 1 to now read "Not available at this time. Included with (PCQ) Grille Screen Protection Package, LPO."

Our friend and Chevy Corvette seller < AHREF="<https://www.corvetteblogger.com/tag/rick-conti/>">Rick Conti told his viewers last week about the supplier constraints and he says that Chevrolet initially accepted a new 2027 ZR1 order with the PCQ Grille Screen Protection Package included but then kicked it back for him to remove the option.

We'll be watching future distribution updates to the Corvette order guide and will let you know when this LPO option becomes available once again for the ZR1 and ZR1X.

Chevrolet Finally Launches 2027 Configurators for Stingray, Z06, and ZR1/ZR1X

Buyers started placing orders for the [2027 model year Corvettes](#) back in April, and it's only as of yesterday afternoon that Chevrolet has finally launched the [Build and Buy Configurators](#) for the 2027 Corvette Stingray, Z06, and the ZR1/ZR1X models. But as with previous model year configurator launches, Chevy's developers are still working on getting it fully functional even as buyers are flocking to the system to build their own dream rides.

Luckily, it appears that full pricing is up from the get-go, even if some of the renderings of your build are replaced with the silhouette of a Chevy SUV.

I attempted first to build a Stingray, but the actual renderings were replaced with the SUV-placeholder after picking my exterior color. For the rest of the build, I was never able to see my creation until it finally appears as a small image on the summary page. Clicking on it just brought up the full-size SUV again.

After a few times of going back and forth between the screens, my build image finally appears! So, I guess the thing to do is to keep trying, and if your build doesn't render correctly, save it and then attempt to come back later.



My second build featuring a Z06 went much smoother and I was able to see my creation on every screen. Perhaps that is due to the Z06 having less new content for the 2027 model year than the Stingray? I got images on every screen now so we're making progress!

I immediately switched over to start building a [Corvette ZR1](#) and that model came in as well as the configurator allowed me to make multiple changes while still rendering the correct image.

For my final masterpiece of the day, I went to the ZR1X configurator and still received all images as intended. I picked the new Pitch Grey Metallic for a ZR1X Convertible and added just the two-tone Sky Cool Gray seats with Blue seat belts. I then went back to the exterior screen and picked the blue brake calipers so I would have a bit of a "theme" with the build. Of course, I added the high wing but if this was really my build, I would probably forgo it as it's just so damn big!

Once I hit the options page, I did go a little cray-cray with Stealth and the Level 2 carbon fiber interior packages. Of course, Front Lift is mandatory for a car like the ZR1X and I went ahead and selected the Corvette Engine Build Experience because you only live once, amirite?

After a couple more options selected which include the R8C Museum Delivery, my build totals \$289,935. Here's the final result:



I wrote this article in real-time as I was configuring these Corvettes, and the takeaway is that if the Configurator isn't rendering images correctly, just stay with it as they eventually all did come in for me. If you are getting the SUV placeholder images, you can always save your creation and then come back when perhaps the configurator may not be as busy.
